







## How To Make Your Zine

1. Fold hotdog style 
2. Fold Hamburger style x2 
3. Unfold and check layout 
4. Fold Hamburger style and cut the middle two panels 
5. Unfold and fold hotdog style 
6. Pop the center and fold into zine 

## Building Shadows

- Find 2-3 source images that consists of a good amount of shadows
- I recommend picking a landscape and portrait that has interesting lighting
- Print each source image twice and use one to draw on top of
- Using the photo, draw over it by filling in the darker areas darker and lighter areas lighter
- By doing this, you want to understand the varying keels of darkness in the scene and exaggerate the lighting conditions
- Focus on where lighting originates

## Source Image

- Your source image can be any photo but make sure to pick a photo with good shadows and a certain level of depth in the scene



## Image With Shading

- Try to understand exact location of the light source in the scene



- Really look to understand the direction of the light

## Image With Shading

- When using a face, we want a source image with a variety of shadows created all over the face and not just in one place
